### Do NOT count

- repetitions
- redundancies (e.g. white cow, brown cow)
- named animals (e.g. Spot, Bambi)

### Do count

- different breeds (e.g. terrier, greyhound)
- gender- or generation-specific names (e.g. bull, cow, heifer, calf)
- imaginary animals (e.g. Unicorn, Dragon)

If the respondent names animals that are unfamiliar to you, give them the benefit of the doubt and count them (e.g. Kudu)

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
