## Housing insecurity histories of UKHLS participants – instructions for using the syntax

The syntax contained in these do files creates a long working datafile containing newly derived variables that capture housing insecurity histories of each responding adult in UKHLS. These variables can then be linked to other individual-level data for analysis.

Follow these steps after downloading the UKHLS data:

- 1. Download the folder titled "housing histories do files".
- 2. Open the do file titled USoc\_housing-history\_master.
- 3. Update line 25 to declare the location of the do files on your computer
- 4. Open the remaining do files and set the working directory and location of UKHLS source data to reflect your local file paths.
- 5. Save changes to all the do files.
- 6. Run USoc\_housing-history\_master.do. This calls on the other do files they do not need to be run separately.

The variables created by the above are:

derived variable	description
	Moved since previous interview [where a mover is anyone asked why they had
move	moved since the previous wave
mov_evict	Reason for move: Eviction/reposession (missing=non-mover)
mov_health	Reason for move: Housing was damp/unhealthy (missing=non-mover)
mov_smlchp	Reason for move: Wanted smaller/cheaper housing (missing=non-mover)
mov_wrkmov	Reason for move: Employer moved job to another workplace (missing=non-mover)
move_invol	Involuntary move (defined as move for any of above reasons) (missing=non-mover)
arrears	Household experienced housing payment problems in past year
	Forced move (alt def): evicted or move coinciding with payment arrears
move_force	[missing=non-mover]
move_cum	Cumulative number of moves since Wave 1
evict_cum	Cumulative number of evictions/reposessions since Wave 1
invol_cum	Cumulative number of involuntary moves since Wave 1
force_cum	Cumulative number of forced moves (evict or move+arrears) since Wave 1
move_ever	Ever moved (since wave 1)
evict_ever	All waves - ever evicted
evict_anytodate	To date - ever evicted
invol_ever	All waves - ever moved involuntarily
invol_anytodate	To date - moved involuntarily
force_ever	All waves - ever forced to move (evicted or move+arrears)
forced_anytodate	To date - ever forced to move (evicted or move+arrears)
arrears_cum	Cumulative number of experiences of being in arrears since Wave 1
arrears_ever	Ever experienced arrears (since wave 1)
arrears_anytodate	To date - ever experienced arrears
L_lkmove	Preference to stay or move (as reported in previous wave)
