

How do I log in to my calendar?

To access the Life History Calendar, please click on the following link (or copy and paste the link in your browser):



To log in to your calendar, you will need to enter your unique login code and password which you will find in the letter/email we have sent you recently. After you've entered the details, press Login.




You will then be asked to enter your date of birth. This is so we can check that the right person is completing the calendar.

After you have entered your date of birth, press 'Go on!'





When you log in, you will be taken to the welcome screen which explains who conducts the study and how we use the information that you will provide here. If you agree and are happy to take part, please tick the statement and then press 'Submit' to continue into the survey.

How do I complete my calendar?

After you have logged in, you will be asked to watch a short video with instructions on how to complete the calendar. Press > in the middle of the page to watch the video. Press 'Go on!' to go to the next screen once you have finished watching the video.



After watching the video, you will be taken to the introductory screen which gives you more information about how to complete the calendar. Press 'Go on!' to start the survey.

The survey starts by asking about the countries you have lived in. You will then be asked questions about education, jobs, marriages and civil partnerships, children, mental health history and physical health history.

You'll be asked for the start and end dates, where applicable, of each event. You only need to enter the month and year. You can enter the dates using the pop-up calendar or by typing them in the format 'mm/yyyy'. If you can't remember dates, your best guess is fine, you can always come back and fix it.

Every screen allows you to add multiple events or spells by pressing on '+' at the bottom of the screen, next to 'Would you like to add an education/ job/country/ etc'. To go to the next section of the survey, press 'Submit':



Once you've entered events the information will show in the timeline at the top of the page, Grey bars show past events and colour bars show current ones:



Every screen contains questions on a different area of your life (residences, education, jobs etc) and becomes a separate tab of the calendar which you can see and access any time by pressing on the tab at the bottom of the page:



You can also click on an entry in the timeline at the top of the screen and you will go back to that section.

You can move between the tabs by adding and editing information that you enter until you complete all the sections. You should then check each section/tab to make sure that the information is correct.

How do I submit my calendar?


When you are happy with the information that you have entered, press 'Submit' which submits your calendar information.




After you have submitted your calendar, you will be asked a few more questions about your employment history, children (their other parent, etc), marriages and civil partnerships (e.g. whether you lived together, whether your partner had children for whom you weren't the natural/adoptive parent), and partners you have lived with for more than 3 months, where applicable.

How do I download my calendar?

At the end of your calendar, click on the 'Download your Life History Calendar' button:



This will open a new window containing your calendar. Click the 'Download image' button at the bottom of the screen. This will download your calendar as a 'JPG' file for you to keep.



After you have downloaded your calendar, please go back to the survey page and click the 'Finish the survey!' button at the bottom of the screen.

The last screen of the survey thanks you for your participation, at which point all of your answers have been submitted.
